The CornerStone FREE HEALTH CLINIC

❖ Medical:

117 patients; 287 clinic visits.

- **Medication:** 1895 prescriptions (30-day supply) valued at \$276,670 were paid for by the clinic.

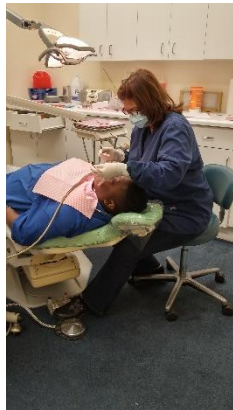
Other prescriptions paid for by patients and including those who get brand medication in the Prescription Assistance Program puts the total value of all prescriptions well over \$600,000.

❖ Dental:

111 patients; 9 dentures; 208 clinic visits.

❖ Vision:

58 patients; 56 Prescription glasses provided.



The CornerStone FOOD PROGRAM

18,945 households (64,669 individuals; 20,237 children; 16,850 seniors; 27,582 adults) primarily from King William and King & Queen counties but includes families from Hanover and Essex.

Food programs include:

USDA Program for families (income based).

WeekEnd Backpack Program addresses child food insecurity.

- 24 bags each week to King William schools
- 65 bags each week to King and Queen schools

Summer Food Program for families that need additional assistance since children are at home during summer vacation (from June to August).

CSFP food boxes for Seniors (income based)

- 75 King William
- 50 King and Queen

The Lily Field Clothing Shed

Free clothing and household items are gathered, sorted and distributed through the year, week after week.



SPECIAL PROGRAMS

- **Back to School** Project – over 500 children received back packs with school supplies.
- **UnderCover** Project - Over 400 children and about 150 adults received new underclothing.
- **Thanksgiving** turkeys distributed to over 500 families.
- **Santa@The CornerStone** - 1151 children received at least three toys each, at Christmas. Toys were donated by local businesses, community groups, churches and the Toys for Tots Foundation. Families from seven counties took pictures with Santa.
- **Wall of Hats. Gloves. Socks and Scarves & Pajamas** - More than a 1000 items of hats, gloves, socks and scarves were distributed to families at Christmas. A special donation of 1006 Pajamas and over 400 books were also distributed.

THE CORNERSTONE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CENTER was incorporated as a 501©(3) organization in 2005.

The CornerStone food program was first started in 2000 with nine families. In 2001, about 70 families came each week to pick up a bag of food. Today, the food programs of 'The CornerStone' continue to be a source of supplemental food to about 400 families. Food is gleaned each day from local stores, donated by churches, individuals and others. Each family receives a bag with bread, produce and meat each week. Families that qualify based on income receive USDA food.

The Lily Field Clothing Shed followed soon after the food program was started.

The CornerStone Free Health Clinic is a medical home to those uninsured. Professional dental care and medical services were started in 2002. For a couple of years' patients were taken to CrossOver Clinic in Richmond for extractions and fillings. A Vision Clinic was added on in 2004. Today all services are located in Aylett and continue to be free of cost to clients & patients.
